



- Stay tuned for the upcoming seminar sessions ...






Student Retreat

- Stay tuned for the upcoming retreat 2025 ...







Support through your PhD: TAC

- Thesis Advisory Committee (TAC) meant to support students in their PhD
 projects.
- Typically needs at least 3 members, i.e. the project PI, two independent researchers (Postdoc/PD/Professor)
- Meeting once a year for discussion, update, and review






D: Instances of discrimination and harassment within the SFB

Thesis Supervision

Important to organize TAC meeting periodically

BCGS Preparatory Conversation Form (for Supervisor and PhD student both)

Discussion material for a preparatory conversation between (potential) PhD candidate and (envisaged)advisor

The purpose of this form' is to talk about the PhD candidate's and the advisor's expectations. This voluntary questionnaire is to be completed individually by both parties. They arrange a meeting where the answers are to be compared and discussed. This exercise may clarify different expectations and will hopefully improve the collaboration. The completed forms stay with the participants in the conversation and are not to be submitted anywhere.

The advisor must be aware of the asymmetric power ratios that exist in the guidance relationship. Academic knowledge and authority shall not be exoluted to with academic or personal benefits.
