

Statute of the Waltraut Seitter-Publication Prize

- i. The SFB1601 awards one publication prize to doctoral students or young scientists (max. 12 months after doctorate) for the best publication of the past academic year (1.10.-30.9.).
- ii. The award winners must be members of the SFB1601.
- iii. The publication must relate to a research topic of the SFB1601 and have been produced within its framework.
- iv. The prize consists of a cash amount of 1,000 € and a certificate.
- v. The award will be presented during the annual SFB1601 members assembly.
- vi. The winners are obliged to give a colloquium within the next month.
- vii. Proposals must be submitted in writing to the Executive Board no later than 30 days before the award ceremony. The proposal must come from an SFB1601 member and contain a justification as well as a CV of the proposed winner and the original publication
- viii. The evaluation committee is the executive board of the SFB1601. External referees can be asked if members of the EB might be biased.
- ix. The decision on the awarding of the prize is not contestable.
